Out of hours works

Rail corridor between Albion and Ginifer stations

6-9 March 2020

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new train stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

To prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure, we will be installing conduit pipes under existing tracks to allow for future transportation of concrete into the rail corridor.

For the safety of rail users and workers, some of these activities can only be performed when trains are not running.

What we are doing


- Using an excavator to dig under the tracks to install PVC pipes underneath. These conduits will carry concrete into the rail corridor for installation of future overhead wiring structures
- Delivering construction materials into the rail corridor.

When

- 9pm, Friday 6 March to 4am, Monday 9 March
- These works are taking place during a scheduled shutdown of the Sunbury rail Line.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the site via St Albans Road under the Western Ring Road
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during nightworks.



Travel changes

To ensure upcoming 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury Line from 8.30pm Friday 6 March to the last service on Sunday 8 March.
