

Works Notification

Site establishment and preparatory works Calder Park

December 2019 - February 2020

We are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade to enable more modern trains to run on the line.

Construction will start in 2020 to expand the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to increase capacity and accommodate new High Capacity Metro Trains, which are longer than existing trains. The train stabling facility is used to maintain and store trains when not in service.

To support these works we are establishing a temporary construction site, offices and staff facilities next to the rail corridor near Holden Road, Calder Park.

We will also be receiving material deliveries and undertaking minor works to prepare the site for new infrastructure.

What we are doing

Preparatory works

- Maintenance of existing access tracks and drainage infrastructure
- Surveying existing land, property and signalling infrastructure to inform design and works planning
- Grass clearing within the new construction site area
- Delivery of materials.

Construction site establishment

- Installing temporary site office sheds, including connection to power and water services
- The site will be used for storage of materials, worker amenities and construction vehicle parking for the duration of Sunbury Line Upgrade works, which are scheduled for completion in 2023.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of


- Low to medium levels of noise and vibration are expected during site preparation and establishment activities
- An increase in construction vehicles including trucks will travel on local roads to access this construction site. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist vehicle movements
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road
- Deliveries of construction material may occasionally arrive after hours. If required, generator-powered lighting towers will be used for safety purposes. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties.
