

Works Notification

Out of hours work Calder Park

30 May - 6 July

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades and expanding the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to accommodate more modern trains. In addition to the May construction update distributed earlier this month, we wish to advise of upcoming out of hours work in your area.

What we are doing

Train stabling facility works

- Delivering and storing construction materials on site
- Operating non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of underground services
- Earthworks involving the use of excavators, bulldozers and vibrating compaction rollers to change ground conditions
- Installation of new drainage, signalling and services infrastructure
- Building new track foundations with soil and ballast (crushed rock) before installing new track that will service the expanded train stabling facility
- Tamping and regulating the new track, a process which compacts and levels out ballast under the newly laid track to align it to its final position.

Overhead wiring works

- Transferring existing overhead wiring to new structures using elevated platforms and telehandlers.

When

- 7am to 7pm each Saturday and Sunday between Saturday 30 May and Sunday 21 June (excluding the Queen's Birthday weekend)
- 8pm, Sunday 14 June to 6am, Thursday 18 June
- 6pm, Friday 26 June to 6am, Monday 6 July.

What to be aware of

- Ground conditions in the local area contain rock which, if encountered, will need to be broken to facilitate these works
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road, Victoria Road and Calder Park Drive. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements around construction sites
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during nightworks
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, some of these activities can only be performed when trains are not running.



Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Sunbury Line Upgrade, as is supporting physical distancing measures in line with current health advice.


We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
