

Works Notification

Site and service investigations Calder Park

21 October - 4 November 2019

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

To prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure, we will be conducting site and service investigations and installing safety fencing at Calder Park.

What we are doing

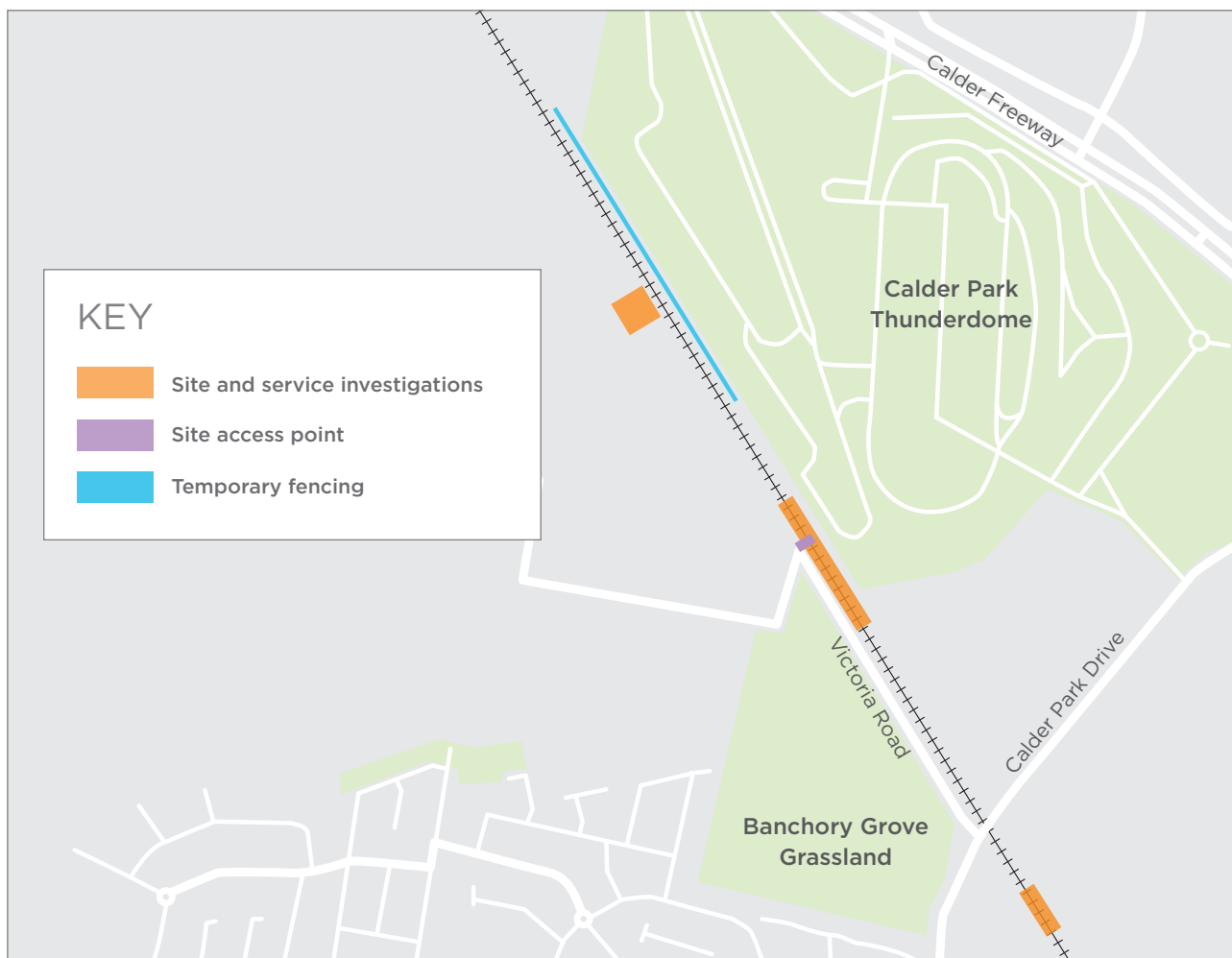
- Using non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks to investigate the location of underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services without damaging them
- Drilling into the ground to obtain rock and soil samples to help us gain a greater understanding of local geological conditions
- Installing temporary fencing to separate workers from operating trains. This will involve an excavator driving fence posts into the ground..

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Victoria Road
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during works at night. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- To ensure the safety of workers and rail users, some of these activities can only be performed when trains are not operating.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday 21 October to Friday 25 October
- 7am to 1pm, Saturday 26 October
- 12.30am, Sunday 3 November to 5am, Monday 4 November.



Travel changes

To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury line at various times in early November.
