

Works Notification

Out of hours works Sunbury station

11 - 14 September 2020

To increase capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade. We will soon be conducting out of hours site and service investigations to prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure.

What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil, exposing assets and services without damaging them
- Drilling into the ground to obtain rock and soil samples to help us gain a greater understanding of local geological conditions
- Transporting excess materials offsite via a rail corridor access point.

When

- 9pm, Friday 11 September
to 6am, Monday 14 September 2020.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Construction machinery will access the rail corridor via Gap Road
- Generator-powered lighting towers may be required at night for safety. Where possible, they will be directed away from residential properties
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, these activities can only be performed when trains are not running.


Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
