

Works Notification

Overhead wiring works

Albion station

1 - 8 September 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will enable bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We wish to advise of upcoming works in your area.

What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of underground services
- Installing piles forming the foundations of new overhead wiring structures. Excavators will drill holes in the ground and remove excess soil before a reinforcement cage is installed and concrete poured in to create the pile
- Temporarily closing up to eight spaces at a time in the Albion station car park to facilitate the operation of construction machinery next to the rail corridor
- Transporting excess material offsite.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- An increase in construction machinery will access the rail corridor during these works. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist vehicle and pedestrian movements around the station car park.

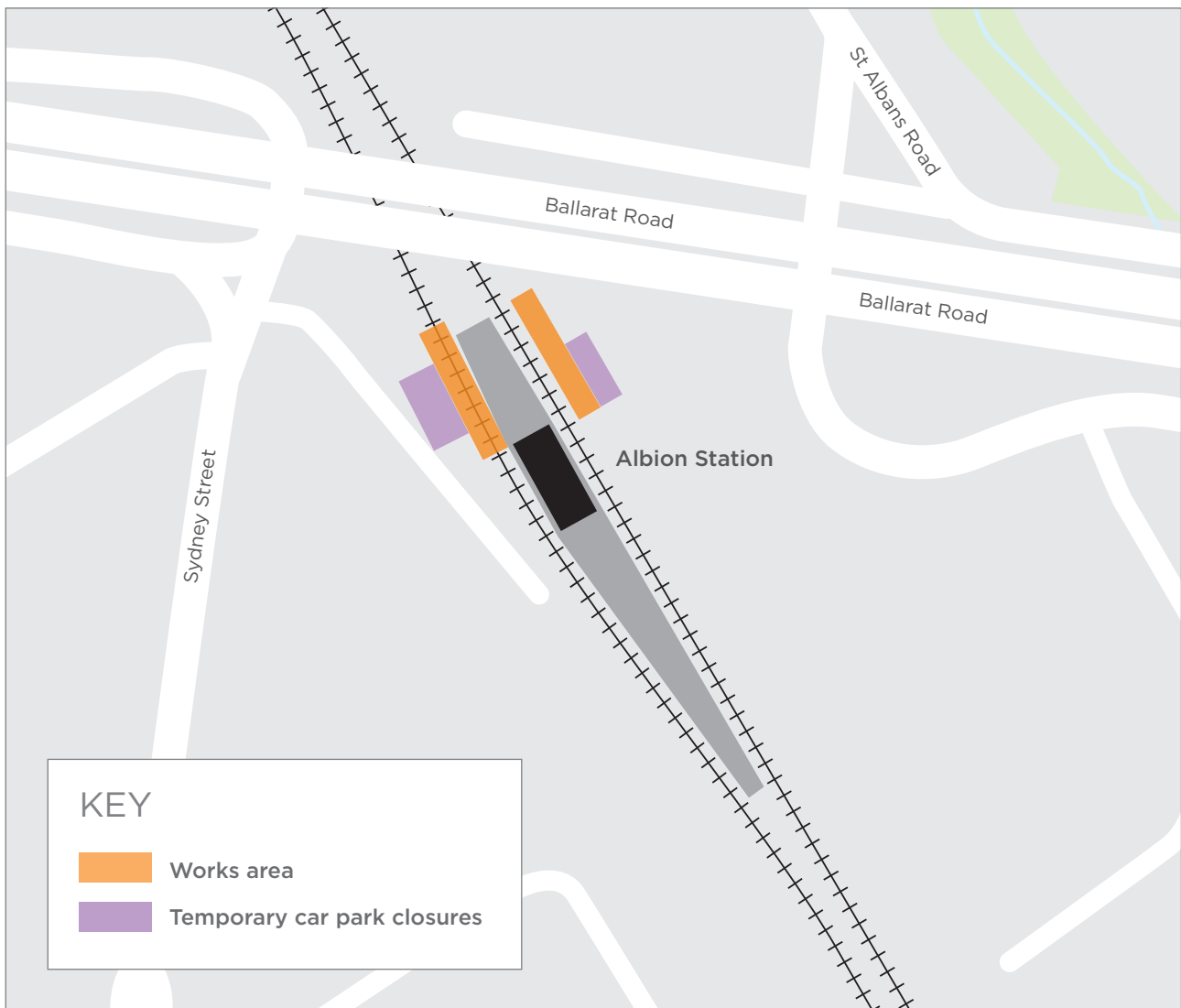
Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
