

Works Notification

Out of hours works and site establishment Sydenham

From 21 October

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, accessibility upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

To support these works, we are establishing a temporary construction site, offices and staff facilities next to the rail corridor, near the corner of Victoria and Sydenham Roads and the Melton Highway in Sydenham.

We will also be conducting site and service investigations to prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure.

What we are doing

Construction site establishment

- A work site caravan will be put in place during normal construction hours in October
- Installing temporary site office sheds, including connection to power and water services
- The site will be used for storage of materials, worker amenities and construction vehicle parking for the duration of Sunbury Line Upgrade works until 2023.

Site and service investigations

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks will operate to investigate the location of underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services without damaging them
- Drilling into the ground to obtain rock and soil samples to help us gain a greater understanding of local geological conditions.

When

Construction site use

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

Site and service investigations

- 7am to 6pm, Monday 21 October to Friday 25 October
- 7am to 1pm, Saturday 26 October
- 12.30am, Sunday 3 November to 5am, Monday 4 November.

What to be aware of

- Low to medium levels of noise and vibration are expected during site establishment activities and site and site investigations
- To allow construction vehicles to operate adjacent to the rail corridor, approximately 29 car spaces in the Watergardens station car park will be closed from 12am, Sunday 3 November to 5am, Monday 4 November. Traffic management will be present to guide pedestrian and vehicle movements
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Victoria and Sydenham roads and the Melton Highway
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during works at night. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- To ensure the safety of workers and rail users, some of these activities can only be performed when trains are not operating.



Travel changes

To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury line at various in during early November.
