

Works Notification

Out of hours works Sunshine station

6-9 March 2020

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

Platforms 1 and 2 at Sunshine station will be extended by 12 and 3 metres respectively. An overhead wiring structure will also be relocated to make way for the extended platform.

What we are doing

Platform extension piling

- Works will take place to install concrete piles forming the foundations of the new platform area
- This involves using excavators to dig through the ground, installing supporting cages and pouring concrete to form the pile.

Overhead wiring foundation piling

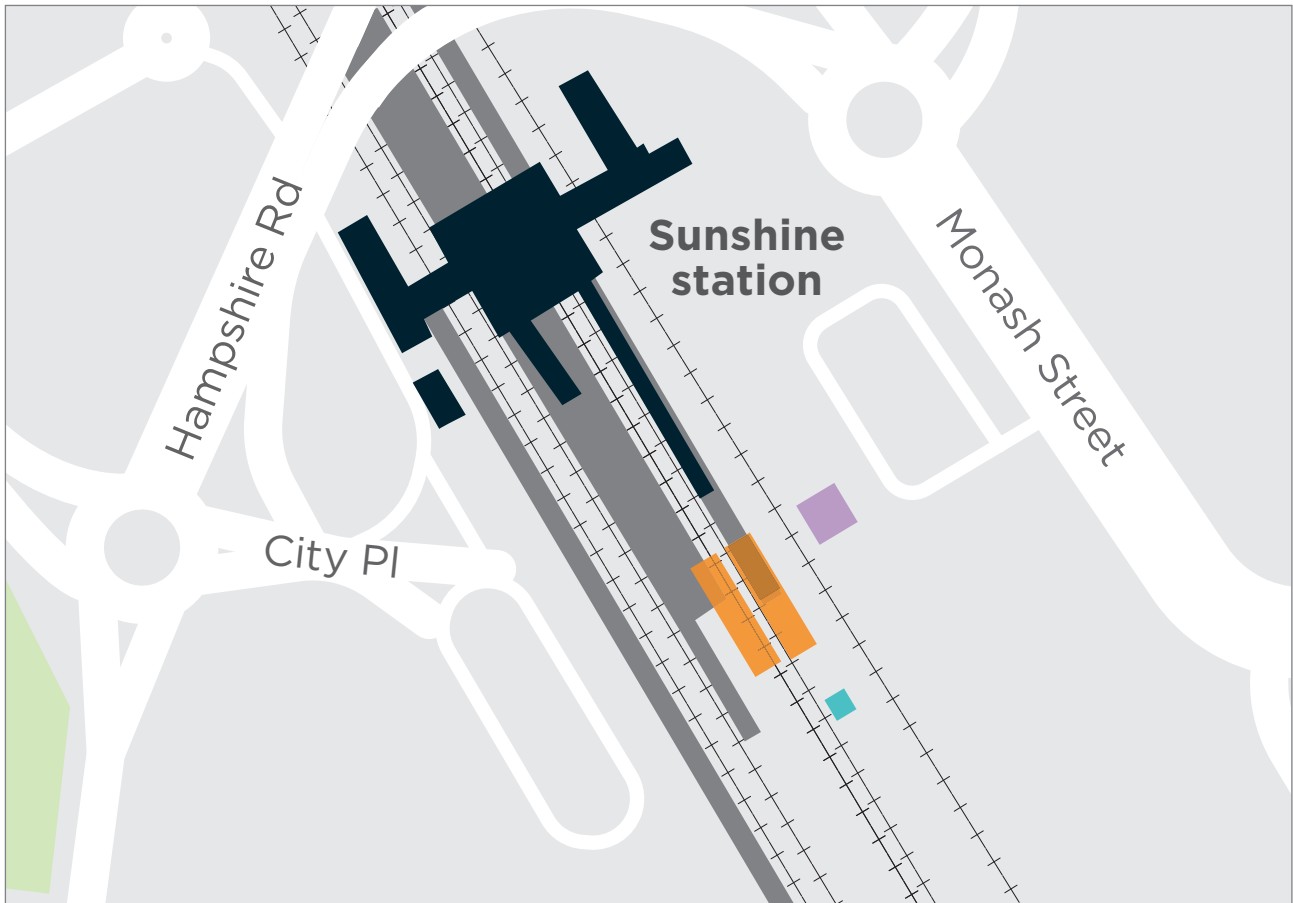
- An additional pile will also be installed in the rail corridor forming the foundation of the relocated overhead wiring structure
- These structures carry the overhead wires that transmit power to trains.




When

- 9pm, Friday 6 March to 4am, Monday 9 March
- These works will take place during a scheduled shutdown of the Sunbury rail line.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration
- A concrete pump will operate adjacent to the rail corridor from within the Sunshine station (Monash Street) car park. No car parking spaces will be impacted however traffic management will be present to assist pedestrian and vehicle movements around the site.
