

## Works Notification

### Construction update Calder Park

May 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades and expanding the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to accommodate more modern trains. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area.

#### What we are doing

##### Train stabling facility works

*Ongoing until late-2020*

- Operating non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of underground services
- Earthworks involving the use of excavators, bulldozers and vibrating compaction rollers to change ground conditions
- Installation of new drainage, signalling and services infrastructure.

##### Overhead wiring installation

*Ongoing to June 2020*

- Installing 64 concrete piles forming the foundations of new overhead wiring structures. Excavators will drill holes in the ground and remove excess soil before a reinforcement cage is installed and concrete poured in to create the pile.

#### When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays
- In addition to normal construction hours, we will also be working from 7am, Saturday 9 May to 4am, Sunday 10 May. These works will take place during a scheduled shutdown of the Sunbury Line for important Metro Trains Melbourne maintenance works.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements around construction sites
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during nightworks.
