

Works Notification

Out of hours works

Rupert Street, West Footscray

30 August - 14 September 2020

Major construction is continuing along the Sunbury rail corridor as part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade. We will be temporarily using the rail reserve at Rupert Street, West Footscray as an access point for construction vehicles to enter the rail corridor.

What we are doing

- Accessing the rail corridor with construction vehicles and machinery
- Temporarily closing up to four on-street car parking spaces to facilitate safe vehicle movements in and out of the site.

When


- 8pm to 6am, Sunday 30 August to Thursday 3 September 2020
- 8pm to 6am, Sunday 6 September to Friday 11 September 2020
- 8pm, Friday 11 September to 6am, Monday 14 September 2020 (24 hour access).

What to be aware of

- Please note that the Rupert Street reserve will be used as a rail corridor access point only. It will not be used for material laydown or storage
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Generator-powered lighting towers may be required at night for safety. Where possible, they will be directed away from residential properties
- There will be an increase in construction vehicles travelling on Rupert Street to access the rail corridor. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle and pedestrian movements around the site.

Travel changes

To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains between North Melbourne and Sunbury from 1.30am Saturday 12 September to last train Sunday 13 September. For journey planning and service information please visit ptv.vic.gov.au or call **1800 800 007**.



Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
