

Works Notification

Out of hours works

Calder Park

11 - 14 September 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades and expanding the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to accommodate bigger, more modern trains. We wish to advise of upcoming out of hours work in your area.

What we are doing

- Service proving works, which involve the use of drilling to identify the exact location of existing services
- Earthworks involving the use of excavators to change ground conditions
- Installation of new drainage, signalling and services infrastructure.

When

- 9pm, Friday 11 September to 6am, Monday 14 September 2020.

What to be aware of

- Ground conditions in the local area contain rock which, if encountered, will need to be broken to facilitate these works. Where possible, any rock breaking activities will be contained to day shifts, however at times, undertaking rock breaking activities at night may be unavoidable
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements around construction sites

- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during nightworks
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, these activities can only be performed when trains are not running.

Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
