

## Works Notification

### Site and service investigations Calder Park

**12-13 September 2019**

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, accessibility upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

These works will allow new longer High Capacity Metro Trains to operate on the network and allow for 113,000 extra passengers to travel in peak periods per week.

To prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure, we will be conducting site and service investigations at Calder Park.

#### What we are doing

- Using non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks to investigate the location of underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services without damaging them
- Drilling into the ground to obtain rock and soil samples to help us gain a greater understanding of local geological conditions.

#### When

- 7am to 6pm, Thursday 12 September to Friday 13 September.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Victoria Road.

#### Travel changes

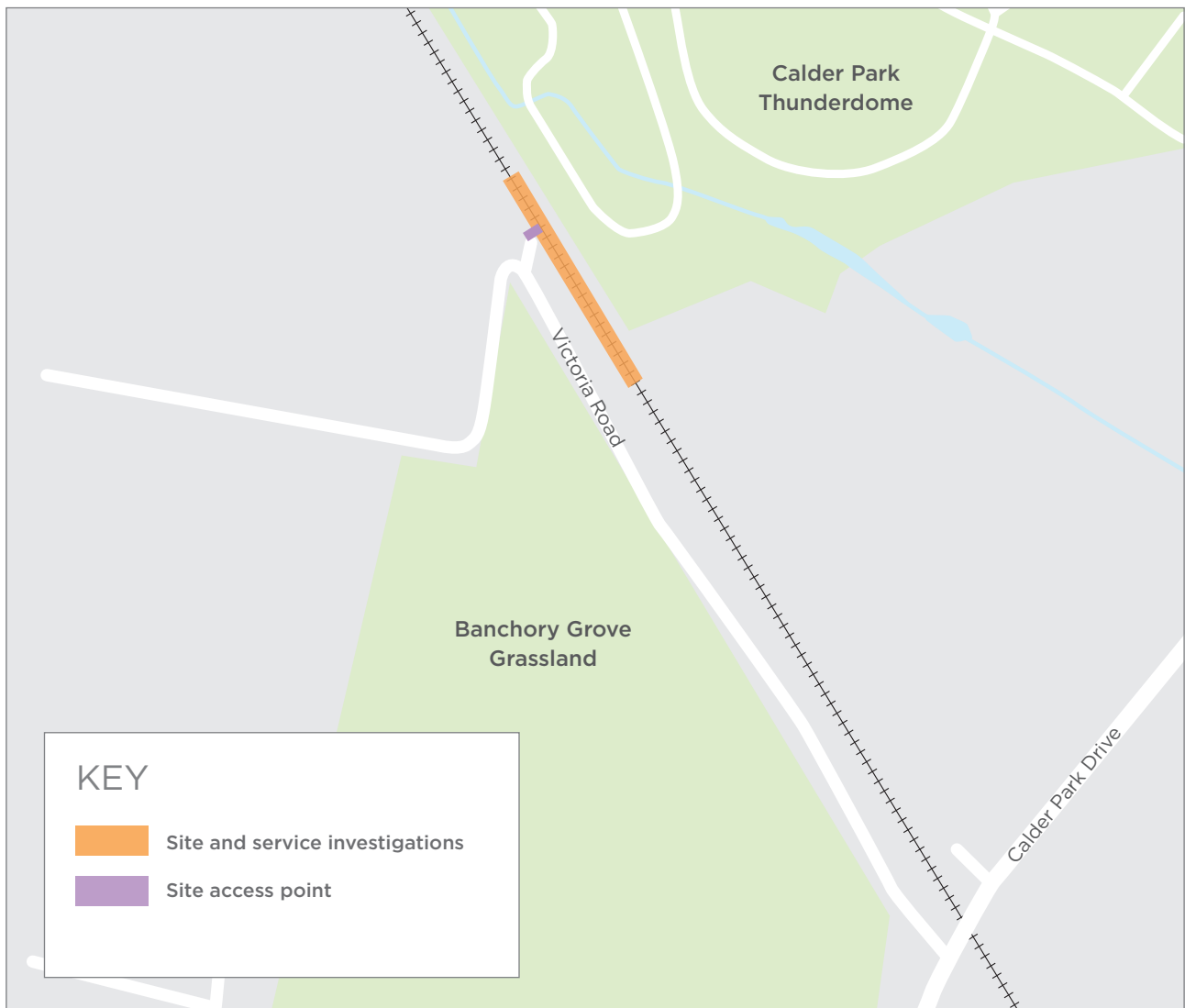
Works are now underway in preparation for a major rail construction blitz commencing at the end of September. This 13-day period will see an unprecedented amount of 24/7 work completed along the Sunbury line that can only take place when trains are not running.

To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains between Flagstaff and Sunshine stations on the Sunbury line from **11.15pm Saturday 28 September to 9pm Friday 11 October**.
