

Works Notification

Site and service investigations Sunbury station

22 June - 6 July 2020

To enable more modern trains to run on the line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade. We will soon be conducting geotechnical investigations to prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure.

What we are doing

Site and service investigations

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and confirm the area is free of underground services. NDD uses pressurized water to break up and vacuum soil, exposing assets and services without damaging them
- Drilling into the ground using a boring rig to obtain rock and soil samples to help us gain a greater understanding of local geological conditions
- Transporting excess materials offsite.

Temporary parking removal

- We will be temporarily closing 10 car parking spaces in the Sunbury station car park over one day during these works to facilitate the operation of a boring rig next to the rail corridor
- A further 24 car parking spaces will be closed for the duration of these works to facilitate temporary storage of construction machinery.

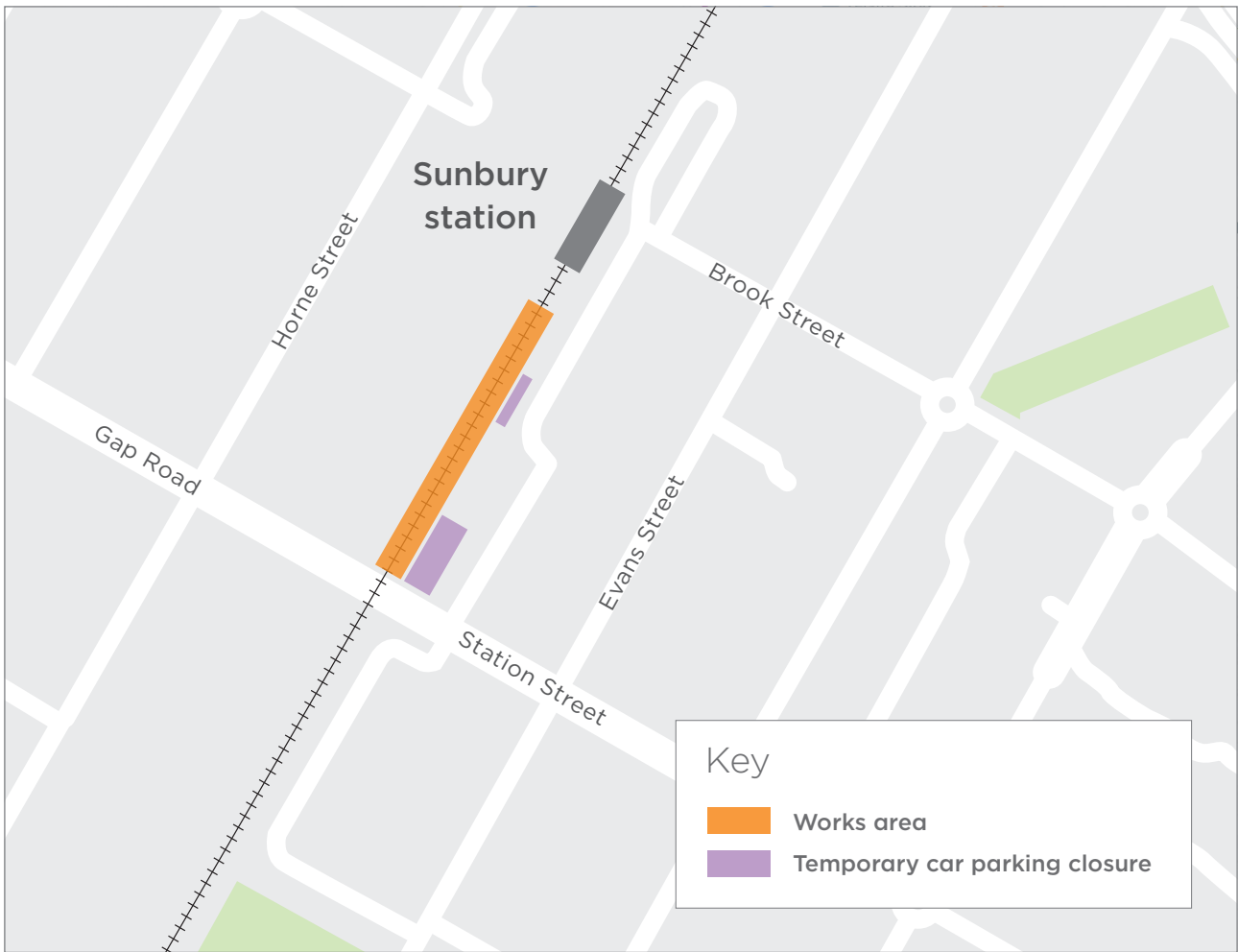
- 7am to 6pm, Monday 22 June to Friday 26 June 2020.

Site and service investigations and temporary parking removal

- 9pm, Friday 26 June to 6am, Monday 6 July 2020
- These works will take place during a scheduled shutdown of the Sunbury rail line.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Generator-powered lighting towers may be required during nightworks
- Please note all other car parking spaces will remain open, with traffic controllers present at times to assist vehicle and pedestrian movements around the site.



Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Sunbury Line Upgrade, as is supporting physical distancing measures in line with current health advice.

We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
