

## Works Notification

### Site establishment works

#### West Footscray station

**From September 14th 2020**

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will enable bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. To facilitate major works that will be starting in late 2020 along the Sunbury Line, we will be establishing a project site office at West Footscray station that will be in operation for up to two years.

#### What we are doing

- Establishing a project site compound including worker amenities and project staff car parking
- This site will be used for office space and the delivery, storage and assembly of materials.

#### Temporary closure of car parking spaces

- Occupying up to 40 parking spaces within the eastern section of the West Footscray station commuter car park on Cross Street. This will allow for the set-up of a crane which is required to facilitate the installation of site offices
- The car park will only be closed for one day

#### When

##### Site establishment activities

- 7am to 6pm, Monday 14 September to Friday 18 September

##### Temporary car park closure

- 6am to 6pm, Monday 14 September

##### Site use

- 7am to 6pm, weekdays
- Ongoing until late 2022

#### What to be aware of

- Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist construction vehicle access, pedestrians and cyclist movements along Cross Street
- An increase of construction vehicles will travel on local roads to access the Cross Street site
- Periods of low to medium level noise are expected during the craning activities. All other activities at this site are expected to generate low levels of noise
- This site will be used for approximately two years by the Sunbury Line Upgrade project and site demobilisation is expected to occur at the end of this period.



### Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
