

## Works Notification

### Construction update Calder Park

September 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades and expanding the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to accommodate bigger, more modern trains. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area.

#### What we are doing

##### Train stabling facility works

*Ongoing until late-2020*

- Using excavators, trucks, vibrating compaction rollers and graders to shape soil and ballast (crushed rock)
- Delivery and welding of new rail track
- Installation of new drainage, signalling and services infrastructure.

##### Substation works

*Ongoing until mid-2021*

- Constructing a new substation at Calder Park that will power bigger, more modern trains, signals and communication equipment. Substations contain equipment which convert local power supply into the voltage needed to run trains on the network
- Excavating and installing conduits underground
- Installing piles that will support the foundations of the new substation and supporting buildings. Piling involves using excavators to dig through the ground, installing supporting cages and pouring in concrete to form the pile.

#### When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements around construction sites.

#### Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
