

Works Notification

Overhead wiring works Calder Park

From 30 March - June 2020

As part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades, platform extensions and additional train stabling that will enable more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We will soon commence construction of new overhead wiring foundations in the rail corridor at Calder Park.

What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and confirm the area is free of underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services without damaging them
- Installing 64 concrete piles forming the foundations of new overhead wiring structures. Excavators will drill holes in the ground and remove excess soil before a reinforcement cage is installed and concrete poured in to create the pile
- Transporting excess material to a site compound at Calder Park.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of


- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road.
