

Works Notification

Construction update Sydenham and Calder Park

From 16 April - 16 May 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are expanding the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to increase capacity and accommodate more modern trains so they can run on the Sunbury Line.

Upcoming works include installation of a rail delineation fence that will allow construction to continue safely while trains are running. To ensure these works can be conducted safely, track signals will be used intermittently to alert train drivers that they are approaching a live construction site within the rail corridor. These signals create a loud noise when sounded.

What we are doing

Calder Park

- Installing temporary fencing that will separate workers from operating trains
- This involves drilling holes into the ground using a small excavator and installing fence posts and chain mesh fencing.

Sydenham

- To alert train drivers they are approaching a worksite in Calder Park, track signals will be used intermittently within the rail corridor at Sydenham. These signals are attached to the track and when run over by a train create a loud noise to alert drivers.

When


- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration, with intermittent periods of high level noise when track signals are set off
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle and pedestrian movements around construction sites.

Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Sunbury Line Upgrade, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice. We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
