Out of hours works

Rail corridor, Tottenham to Sunshine stations

6-9 March 2020

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

To prepare the rail corridor for new infrastructure, we will be conducting site and service investigations between Tottenham and Sunshine stations.

What we are doing

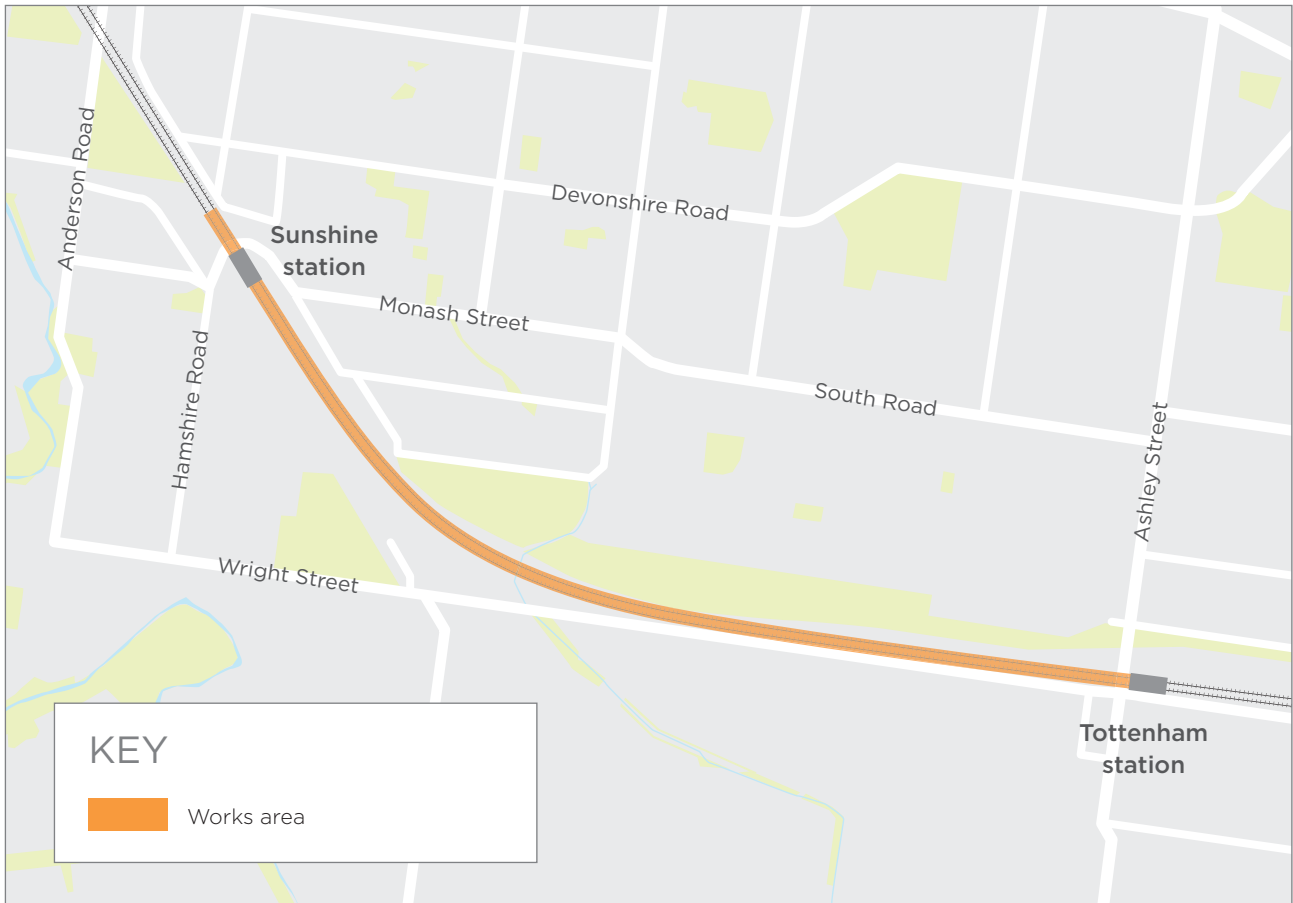
- Non-destructive digging trucks will operate within the rail corridor to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of underground services
- NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil, exposing assets and services without damaging them.

When

- 9pm, Friday 6 March to 4am, Monday 9 March 2020
- These works will take place during a scheduled shut down of the Sunbury rail line.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the rail corridor via Sunshine Road
- Lighting towers powered by generators are required during nightworks within the rail corridor. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- To ensure the safety of workers and rail users, these activities can only be performed when trains are not operating.



Travel changes


To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury Line from 8.30pm Friday 6 March to the last service on Sunday 8 March.
