

## Works Notification

### Upcoming works Calder Park

16-24 April 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are expanding the existing train stabling facility at Calder Park to increase capacity and accommodate more modern trains so they can run on the Sunbury Line.

Works will soon take place to strengthen the ground conditions at Calder Park in preparation for new rail infrastructure. This will be done through lime stabilisation, a process in which lime is added to existing soil to increase its stability.

#### What we are doing

- Placement of crushed rock and soil with excavators and tandem trucks
- Application of lime and cement for stabilisation. Once applied, a machine slowly mixes the lime and cement into the soil, increasing ground stability
- Compacting the ground using a drum roller.

#### When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to produce medium levels of noise and vibration
- The soil, lime and cement mixing process is expected to generate medium levels of dust and steam. A water cart will be used to dampen the soil and minimise the spread of dust
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Holden Road and Victoria Road.

#### Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Sunbury Line Upgrade, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice. We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
