

Works Notification

Temporary car park closures Raleigh Street, Footscray

12 June - 6 July 2020

Major construction is continuing along the Sunbury rail corridor as part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade.

Buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury Line between Friday 26 June and Monday 6 July, during which works will take place 24 hours a day along the rail corridor between Sunbury station and the Maribyrnong River. To facilitate material laydown and access into the rail corridor, we are temporarily closing a section of the Raleigh Street car park to public traffic.

What we are doing


- The southern Raleigh Street car park will be temporarily closed and used for delivery and storage of construction materials
- The site will also be used as an access point for construction vehicles into the rail corridor.

When

- 6pm, Friday 12 June to 6am, Monday 6 July 2020.

What to be aware of

- Up to 40 spaces at the southern Raleigh Street car park will be temporarily closed to facilitate these works
- Please note that the car park on the northern side of Raleigh Street will remain open
- These works are expected to create medium levels of noise from construction vehicle movements and material unloading.
- There will be an increase of construction vehicles travelling on local roads to access Raleigh Street. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist construction vehicle and pedestrian movements around the site
- Temporary lighting will be used during night works. Where possible they will be positioned so they face away from residential properties.



Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Sunbury Line Upgrade, as is supporting physical distancing measures in line with current health advice.

We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
