

## Works Notification

### Platform and out of hours works Tottenham station

**19 February-9 March 2020**

To enable greater capacity on the Sunbury Line, we are delivering platform extensions, power upgrades and new stabling as part of the \$2.1 billion Sunbury Line Upgrade.

Upcoming works at Tottenham station include installation of new accessibility features on the platform and supporting power and communications equipment. For the safety of rail users and workers, some of these activities can only be performed when trains are not running.

#### What we are doing

- Installing a raised boarding pad and two accessible platform shelters, using a small crane mounted onto the train tracks to lift each shelter in place
- Installing conduits to service communications and CCTV around the new shelters. This involves cutting asphalt and breaking concrete, laying conduits in trenches and then reinstating the platform.

#### When

##### Platform works (dayworks)

- Wednesday 19 February to Tuesday 25 February
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

##### Platform works (out of hours)

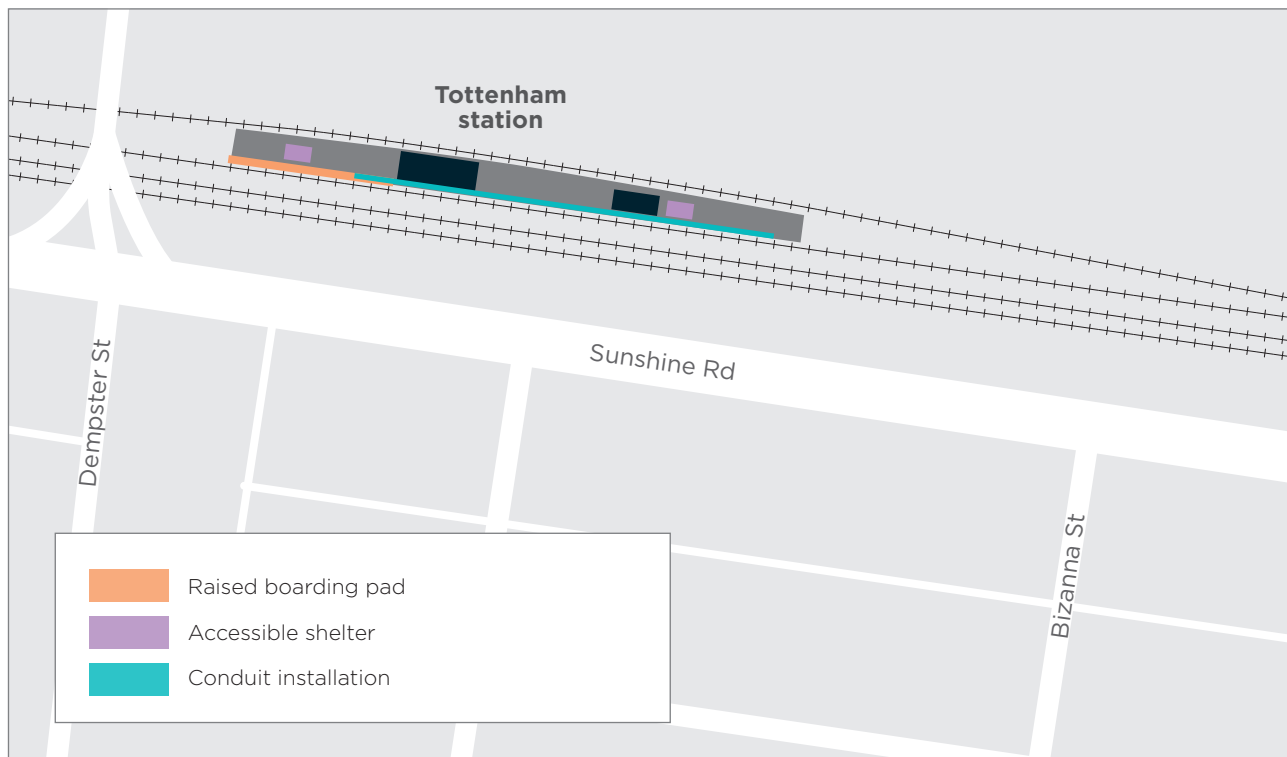
- Tuesday 25 February to Friday 6 March
- 8pm to 5am, Monday to Sunday.

##### Platform works (24/7 works)

- 8pm Friday 6 March to 4am Monday 9 March
- These works are taking place during a scheduled shutdown of the Sunbury rail line.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration.
- At times, work will take place on the platform while trains are running. The construction area will be separated from train users with barriers. Please move carefully around the station platform while boarding and disembarking from trains
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be used during works at night. Where possible, these will be faced away from residential properties.



### Travel changes


To ensure the 24-hour works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury Line from 8.30pm Friday 6 March to the last service on Sunday 8 March.
