

Works Notification

Overhead wiring works

Rail corridor between Tottenham
and Watergardens stations

From 20 April - October 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will enable more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We will soon commence construction of new overhead wiring foundations along the rail corridor between Tottenham and Watergardens stations.

What we are doing

- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and confirm the area is free of underground services. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services without damaging them
- Installing piles forming the foundations of 170 new overhead wiring structures that will supply power to trains. Excavators will drill holes in the ground and remove excess soil before a reinforcement cage is installed and concrete poured in to create the pile
- Transporting excess material offsite.

When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- An increase in construction machinery will access the rail corridor at various locations during these works. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist vehicle and pedestrian movements around construction sites

- Construction activity will move progressively along the rail corridor, with work commencing at Tottenham and Watergardens in April. NDD and piling at each foundation location will be completed over a number of days before work crews move onto the next location.

Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Sunbury Line Upgrade, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice. We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
