Out of hours works

Rail corridor between Calder Park and Sunbury

24 August-4 September

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will enable bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. To prepare the rail corridor for future works, we will be conducting site investigations in your area.

What we are doing

- Performing service inspections at five substations along the Sunbury Line: Sunbury, Jacksons Hill, Diggers Rest, Holden Road and Calder Park
- Operating non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of underground services.

Where

Works will be taking place in the rail corridor nearby the following locations:

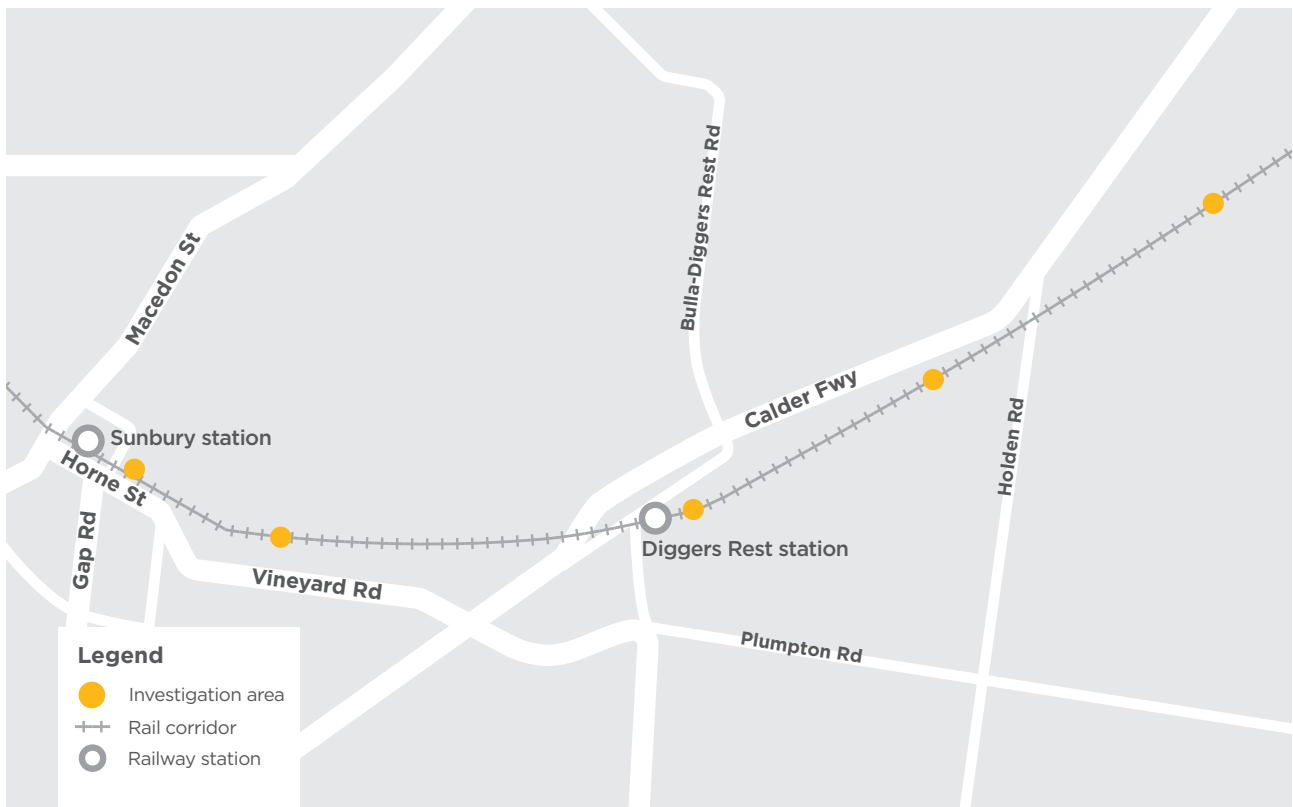
- 81-87 Horne Street, Sunbury
- 6 Lark Court, Sunbury
- Diggers Rest station car park, Diggers Rest
- Holden Road, Diggers Rest
- Calder Park Victoria Road, Sydenham.

When

- Monday 24 August to Friday 4 September
- 12am to 4am, Monday to Friday
- Works may take up to two nights to complete at each location during this period.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise
- There will be an increase in construction vehicles travelling on local roads to access worksites
- Generator-powered lighting towers may be required at night for safety. Where possible, they will be directed away from residential properties
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, these activities can only be performed out of hours when trains are not running.



Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
