

Works Notification

Out of hours works

St Albans

6 - 10 September 2020

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will enable bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We will soon be undertaking out of hours work in St Albans to install new infrastructure within the rail corridor.

What we are doing


- Installing 13 new overhead wiring structures. This involves the use of rail-mounted or truck-mounted cranes to lift steel structures within the rail corridor. Workers on elevated platforms will then use hand tools to complete installation
- Drilling bridge fittings at Ginifer station.

When

- 9pm to 4am, Sunday 6 September to Thursday 10 September 2020.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and low levels of vibration
- Construction vehicles will access the rail corridor at Willaton Street near Curtin Street. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist vehicle and pedestrian movements around the site
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be required during nightworks. Where possible, they will be faced away from residential properties.



Health and safety

The Sunbury Line Upgrade is a critical state infrastructure project under Stage 4 restrictions, allowing work to continue with strict health and safety measures in place.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority and we have measures in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer, and we are continuing to manage the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites.
